

1. How to Dispose of Household Garbage

Tochigi City collects household garbage and other items separately.

Please separate garbage properly and dispose of it at the designated garbage station by 8:30 a.m. on the designated day, in the designated manner.

Each household may dispose of up to three 45-liter bags of trash at a time.

Please write your name and the name of your town on the bag.

There are three types of designated garbage bags: burnable trash bags, empty can and glass bottle bags, and plastic bottle and food tray bags.

Please purchase them at supermarkets and drugstores in the city.

The designated days are listed on the garbage calendar.

To separate your garbage, see the notice for "How to Separate and Dispose of Garbage" which has been translated into English, Chinese, Korean, Spanish, Portuguese, and Nepalese, and can be found on the Tochigi City website.

The event will run from November 28 to January 8, 2024. Lighting hours are from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

The location is at the east exit of Tobu Shin-Ohirashita Station and around Platz Ohira.
