School expense subsidy system for FY 2025

Tochigi City provides financial assistance to parent(s)/guardian(s) who have difficulty in having their child(ren) attend school for financial reasons. Subsidies are provided to cover some of the cost of school supplies and lunch expenses so that the students can be encouraged to go to school without worrying about financial problems.

1. Eligibility

- Households that have an address in Tochigi City, have elementary or junior high school students, and are receiving public assistance. (“*You hogosha*”)
- Households that have been recognized by the Board of Education (BOE) as being in financial difficulty equivalent to receiving public assistance and in need of assistance with attending school. (“*Junyou hogosha*”)

【Eligibility for “Junyou hogo”】 If either of the following conditions below (① or ②) applies, you are eligible for subsidies.

① **Households which have been given or will be given any of the following benefits from April 1st, 2025. (If those benefits are canceled during the period of April 1, 2025 to March 31, 2026, the financial aid will also end at the same time.)**

- a) Suspension/discontinuation of public assistance
- b) Exemption of residence tax
- c) Reduction of residence tax
- d) Reduction of property tax
- e) Reduction of National Pension Premium payment
- f) Reduction of National Health Insurance tax
- g) Receipt of “Jidofuyo teate” (Child-Rearing Allowance)
- h) Receipt of a loan for livelihood welfare fund*
- i) Reduction of enterprise tax

*h) Loan for livelihood welfare funds are limited to loans from the Social Welfare Council.

② **If either of the following conditions below (a or b) applies and if the BOE has certified that your child(ren) has/have difficulties in attending school for financial reason, you are eligible for subsidies.**

a) Households in which **the total income of the same household** in the previous year is less than **1.3** times the minimum living expenses calculated by the Board of Education based on the standards set by the Minister of Health, Labor and Welfare according to Article 8, Paragraph 1 of the Public Assistance Act.

b) Households whose income is significantly reduced due to illness or disaster, and who are in need of assistance

- After receiving the application form, **we will check the total income of the household during the previous year.** If you have not made a year-end tax adjustment at your workplace, please complete the income declaration at the tax office or the municipal tax section of the city hall.
- If your registered address as of January 1, 2025 is outside of Tochigi City, please acquire your “Income Certificate of 2024” in June from the municipality where your previous address was registered.

※ The same household refers to all persons who share the same livelihood, regardless of the type of household on the resident registration.

※ If there is anyone in your household whose income is unknown, you will not be qualified for subsidies.

○ **Approximate amount of income to receive the subsidy**

(The amounts below are just examples. The calculation may differ depending on the ages and residential conditions even if your household composition is the same as the list.)

2. How to apply

<Application period> From Mon. 3rd March 2025 to Fri. 11th April 2025

<Place of submission> Tochigi City Board of Education, “Kyoiku Somuka” (Education and General Affairs section (4th floor of the City Hall) (Submission by mail is also accepted.)

To apply, get an application form either at the Tochigi City Board of Education or at school. Fill in the form and submit it to Kyoiku Somuka (Education and General Affairs section) of the Board of Education. (Those receiving welfare benefits do not need to apply.)

- Even if the household was authorized last year, re-application is needed every year.
- A district welfare commissioner may make inquiries after you apply for the subsidy.
- If eligible households submit a form during the above application period, certification will be effective from April 1.

※Investigation result will be sent through school around July. Payment of subsidies will be made three times (around July, December, and March) through school.

• For applications completed after the above application period, the deadline is the end of every month. (When that day is Saturday, Sunday or National holiday, the deadline will be the next operation day) The certification date will be the 1st of the following month.

※It will take about 2 months to investigate your qualification and make grant decision.
